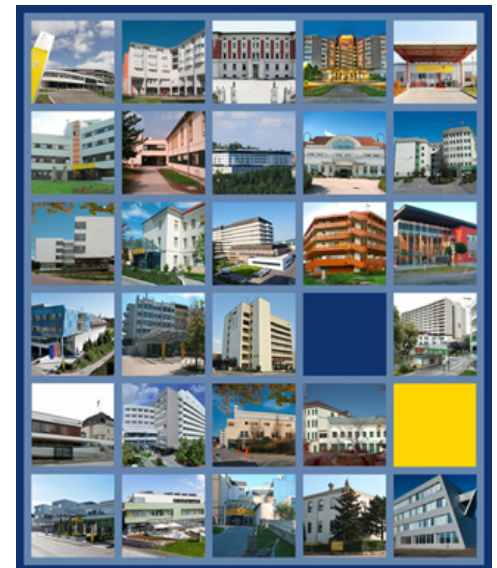

## Behaviour after a curettage ■

### **Dear Patient,**

A curettage has been performed to remove tissue from your uterus.

Further to our discussion at discharge and the doctor's letter, we would like to provide you with some more information relating to the time after your stay in hospital.

## Behaviour after a curettage ■

Please observe the following for the most favourable treatment outcomes:

- Physical rest for one week
- Avoid sexual intercourse for one week
- Avoid full baths and visiting the sauna and swimming pool for at least one week
- Avoid using tampons for one week

## Behaviour after a curettage ■

In the case of pain or bleeding which is more intense than for normal menstruation, a check-up with your consultant or the gynaecological outpatient clinic is recommended.

The duration of sick leave will be determined by your GP.
